- Income: the PCC is suffering a financial crisis caused by the loss of some major donors. PCC needs to reach out to more individuals/families recently moved to the village.
- Outreach: formation of a prayer group for newcomers suggested by Marigold Pym.
- Village Magazine: the magazine lost money in 2022 but this should be reversed in the current year.
- Deanery Synod: the next meeting of the deanery synod is May 23rd. All welcome.
- School: a vacancy exists on the school governing body for a Foundation Governor appointed by the PCC.
- Ringers: the bells are in good order, but new ringers needed. The bells are to be rung for the Coronation on 6th May 2023 at 9.30 am for 30 mins.
- Safeguarding: the diocese provides excellent support for any safeguarding issue.
- Thanks: the vicar and others were warmly thanked by several parishioners for all they do in the life of the church.
